AUDITION PREREQUISITES

1. Must currently study with a private music teacher and have a minimum of 3 years consecutive study on your instrument.

2. A letter of recommendation from your private music teacher (please include with your application below).

3. Some previous youth orchestra experience preferred, but not required.

WHAT TO PREPARE FOR YOUR AUDITION

<u>Scales</u>. Demonstrate with a minimum 2 octave Major, and one Minor (natural, harmonic, or melodic) scale on your instrument.

Recommended scales per instrument are:

Flute - B and Ab Oboe - D and E Clarinet - F and Eb Bassoon - Bb and E French Horn - Bb below middle C and F below middle C Trumpet - G and Eb Trombone - Bb and A Bass Trombone - Eb below the staff and D below the staff Tuba - F and D Violin - G and a minor Viola - G and a minor Cello - D and c minor Double Bass - G and e minor Harp - Any Percussion - No Scales. 2 pieces, one for mallet instruments and the other for timpani or drum set.

<u>Solo Pieces</u>. Perform 2 solo pieces of your choice in contrasting styles (for example, a sonata and a concerto - no etudes please) that demonstrate your musicianship and technique. It is recommended that your presentation should be at recital performance level.
